Snowline Hospice will be moving from its current location at 670 Placerville Dr, Placerville, on June 1. Business operations at the new building will begin on Monday, June 4. Snowline Hospice was able to purchase four beautiful acres of land from the Federated Church in 2006. Plans for the site include the In-Home Patient Services building, a six-bed hospice home, and healing garden areas for patients and staff. To celebrate the completion of its new building, a grand opening will be held in the fall.
