RIBBON CUTTING AND OPEN HOUSE SCHEDULED FOR SNOWLINE HOSPICE

(Diamond Springs, CA)- It is time to celebrate! Snowline Hospice is holding a grand opening celebration of its new In-Home Patient Services Building on Wednesday, September 19. The open house is scheduled from 4-7 pm with the ribbon cutting ceremony scheduled for 4:30 pm.

Snowline Hospice has provided end of life care for El Dorado County and Folsom since 1981 however it has never had a permanent home until now. Construction of the new In-Home Patient Services facility was completed in June and fulfilled a long held dream of Snowline Hospice- a permanent place to call home. The new building houses the patient care and administrative staff.

“It is great for Snowline to finally have a permanent home,” said Jeff Henderson, Executive Director, “This new site allows us to better serve our patients, families, and the community by providing us much needed space for our current staff and also room to grow in the future.”

Long term plans for the site include the addition of a six bed hospice home and a landscaped memorial garden. The hospice home will provide a place for patients to live out their last days in a peaceful setting with round the clock care. There is a great need for the hospice home because there is not currently a place that is able to provide comfort care when hospitalization is not necessary but home care is not enough.
